During the visit to Japan, on April 6th 2017, Prof. Dr. Tran Van Nam – President of UD visited and signed a cooperation agreement with Kobe City College of Nursing. This is one of the best universities specialized in nursing training in undergraduate and postgraduate level in Japan.

The delegation on Japanese side included Prof. Shizue Suzuki - President, Prof. Keiko Nonimiya – Vice President, Heads of related departments and representatives of faculty members and staff.
